Gardening Club

Oasis nursery provision is based here at the children's centre for children aged 3-4. Free nursery places are available for 15 hours through the Government's early years funding scheme. We offer AM Sessions 8.30-11.30 or PM sessions 12-3pm. With its extensive links with the primary school, the nursery provides the perfect introduction to learning and gives the children confidence and skills to transfer smoothly to their primary reception classes when they reach school.
