Message from Miss Charles, Miss Howard, Mrs. Downton and Mr. Sharp...

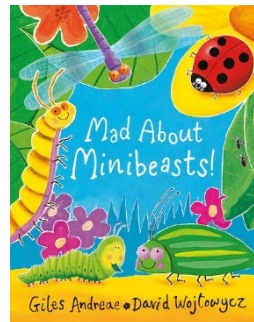

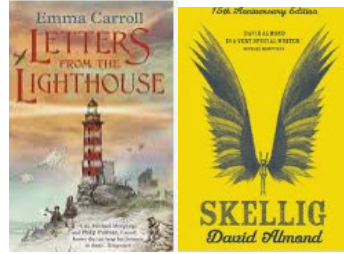
