## LIFE Week 2023

### What is it?

**Three days in school, but off timetable.**

That means, pupils will be in school, however, will not be participating in their usual lessons.

**Instead**, pupils will have the opportunity to pre-select a variety of activities on offer to them, either onsite (at school), or offsite (on a trip).

All activities, onsite and offsite are open to students in Year 7-10 unless stated otherwise.



There are enough offers onsite and offsite to ensure that every pupil is registered onto an activity at all times throughout the day. However, spaces are limited on each activity. **So, book early, to avoid disappointment** in not getting your first choice of activity.

All pupils will arrive at school at the normal time (8.30am) for registration and form time. They will then either go offsite or stay onsite and take part in their chosen activities.

### Why do we have a week of LIFE?

At Shirley Park, we want to develop the hearts and minds of all our pupils. We want to provide our pupils with the opportunities to try new things and find activities that they enjoy and excel at!

Enrichment activities help children to develop their social skills and learn how to work in a team to achieve great things. They help children explore different areas of interest, increase self confidence, build leadership skills and most importantly have fun!

### Attendance and Behaviour

Attendance to this week is compulsory, and not attending will affect your child's overall attendance percentage. Non-attendance will be followed up using our normal OASP attendance systems.

Registration is at 8.30am each day in tutor groups. If pupils are late, the same rules will apply, they will have to sit a late detention and miss out on one of the activities in the day. If they are going offsite, they might miss the offsite activity due to missing the departure time.

Throughout the day students will be expected to demonstrate our school values and exemplary behaviour. We will continue to follow our school behaviour systems during this week to ensure a safe environment throughout the week.

## How much will this cost?

In order to ensure that all students have access to a variety of activities, we have worked hard to ensure that the vast majority of the events across the week are free.

**Therefore, we ask families to pay £5 to support this exciting week.**

**Please pay this by Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> June.**

All onsite activities are free. There are optional offsite activities provided which carry an additional cost depending on the activity

**Step 8:** Select the activities for each day

If an option is in this booklet and **not** on the form, it means that activity is full. Please select something else.

### How to set up a Gmail account for the first time:

- 1) Search Create a Google account
- 2) Click create an account
- 3) Enter your name
- 4) You can either create a new Gmail username or select 'use my own email address instead' this option allows for students to use their Oasis Shirley Park emails.
- 5) Follow the remaining steps on the page. To verify your account and get it set up.

If you or your parent have a Gmail account already, you do not need to make a new one.

## How parents' book onto Offsite Activities

### Parent Pay

Due to the high level of traffic that occurs on parent pay when trip bookings go live, the system can sometimes be slow. Please be assured that it uses a virtual queue and tickets for trips will be allocated on a first come first serve basis.

Last year trip bookings sold out very fast. We are unable to add any spaces on once trips are full. We will operate a waiting list, which will be sent out via email to all parents on Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> July.

## Examples of costs for the week

- A student who stays onsite all week, with no offsite trips. Cost = £5
- A student who goes to Thorpe Park and stays onsite for the rest of the week.  
Cost = £5 + £30 = £35
- A student who goes to the museum trip and stays onsite for the rest of the week.  
Cost = £5 + £0 = £5
- A student who goes to Kew Gardens, London Zoo and onsite for the rest of their time.  
Cost = £5 + £7.50 + £30 = £42.50
- A student who goes on trips all week must pay for their trips **and** the onsite cost of £5.  
Example: Brighton Trip, Thorpe Park and London Dungeons.  
Cost = £25 + £30 + £15 + £5 = £75

- If your child is eligible for free school meals, we will provide them with a pack lunch if you would like us to. Please provide the relevant information on the booking pages.
