

## Female anonymity

- ↳ Female stories marginalised and replaced by male narratives
- ↳ 'Anon' acknowledges female existence
- ↳ No specific name, Duffy relates all female experience

Anon

Carol Ann Duffy

woman  
If she were here

Instead of "was" → Formal tone

- Distance → Not personal, but still worthy of legacy
- Respect → Duffy admires women
- Plural suggests 'she' is collective

Caesura  
↳ Expect climax

Continues theme →  
of anon -  
yanity

A girl I met

was willing to bet

that she still lived on

Anon. ← Anti-climax

but had packed it all in, given up

the best verb, the right noun,  
morally  
for a life in the sun.

- ↳ Chosen for them by men so alienated from their own identities
- ↳ Conflict between internal and external identity

Enduring experience of women

Alliteration of 'n'

- ↳ Predictable/repetitive like their lives
- ↳ Trivial, nursery rhyme tone

- ↳ Female identity trivialised

A woman I knew  
kept her skull  
on a shelf in a room -  
Anon's -  
and swore that one day  
as she worked at her desk  
it cleared its throat  
as though it has something  
to get off its chest.

Shakespearean reference to Hamlet  
'To be or not to be'  
↳ Identity vs anonymity  
↳ Life vs death  
↳ Easy  
↳ Legacy

Women are destined to fail while they  
live in a materialistic society that  
forces women to choose between  
freedom and identity, and  
comfort and security.

Transgressive  
women are  
punished and  
outcasts

↳ Only exceptional women  
get to have a legacy

Locked away → most women avoid the conflict

Repressed idea re-emerges and demands consideration

Burden  
Women have the difficult choice of identity

But I know best -  
how she passed on her pen  
like a baton  
down through the years,  
with a hey nonny

Could be a criticism of female reluctance and obduracy  
OR she takes their burden and gives them their identity

Passing on female story → Could be a reflection of Duffy's  
own inspiration by female writers  
e.g. her teachers

Simile

↳ Relay → women work together

↳ Could be a phallocentric [phallus]  
↳ Female taking over of phallocentrism

Anti-climax?

Is Duffy  
doubtful?

OR is she  
confident

Nonsensical Elizabethan

↳ Refer to 'nothing' i.e vaginas

↳ Reveals how a) women deserve automatic and legacy just  
like men get for having a phallus

b) ridicules phallocentrism and shows how
