'The world beyond my window'





This Year 8 Geography Project gives young people the chance to explore the potential that geography holds. Although we might all be confined to our homes, and doing #geographyathome, we are asking young people to explore their wider geographical horizons by presenting:

'The world beyond my window'

We are interested in projects that explore the human and physical geography of places that exist beyond a young person's window, be it locally or further afield.

We want to know how young people's lives are connected to and influenced by these places - be the connections physical, digital or emotional.

We also want to understand how geographical processes in the physical and human worlds have created these places and might be changing them.

Year 8 students will produce an **A3 size** entry. This can be **hand-made** (then sent in electronically via a scanned copy or photograph) or using **PowerPoint**, **word**, **publisher or PDF**, etc.

All projects should address the theme, The world beyond my window and must meet the following criteria:

- Describe two or more geographical ideas relating to what you can see through your window
- Use at least two annotated images, diagrams, charts or maps
- Excellent attention to spelling, punctuation and grammar
- Use of accurate geographical terminology
- Clearly labelled and appropriately acknowledged sources, including diagrams, charts, maps or images
- Accurate use of symbols, scales and keys

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- Original and independently produced—class sets of identical entries will not be accepted or entries which have copied information from other sources, such as the internet
- If produced electronically, please use a minimum font size of point 10

Given the COVID situation entries can only be submitted as an electronic copy, scan or photo by 15th June 2020.
