

## Expressive Arts and Design

- Practicing colour mixing.
- Beginning to identify different media
- Songs and action rhymes relating to growth and change
- Building with different construction sets
- Engage in imaginative role-play linked to stories.

## Communication, Language and Literacy

- Phonic skills learning initial letters, blending and segmenting words.
- Exploring rhymes and rhythmic texts

## Physical Development
