Science

Animals including humans – Our Pets (Summer 1)

Children will identify and name a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals. We will be sorting animals in groups according to whether they could be a pet or not and finding out why. We will also be thinking about what our pets need to be happy

Plants and Growing (Summer 2)

We will look at all different kinds of plants including wild and garden. We will also identify and name the different parts of plants and do some close observational drawings of them.

Maths

In our maths lessons this term, we will be learning the following topics:

- Numbers 50 to 100 and beyond
- Addition and subtraction beyond 20
- Money
- Multiplication and division
- Measures: Capacity and Volume.

Topic

Our topic for the first half term is '**Minibeasts**'.

We will start the topic with a visit from the 'Wiggly Wild Show'.

We will be creating fact files about minibeasts and writing non-chronological reports. We will be learning about the life cycles of butterflies and frogs and writing poems and riddles about minibeasts.

Our topic for the second half term is '**Africa**'. We will be looking at the culture, the people, the animals. We will be reading stories from Africa, listening to African Music, making African masks.

Maths

In our maths lessons over the term we will be learning the following topics:

- To recognise the place value of each digit in a 3-digit number
- To compare numbers within 1000 using the $<$, $>$ and $=$ signs
- To accurately read scales within 1000 units
- To measure capacity and volume, reading scales
- To explore a variety of calculation strategies
- To consolidate multiplication and division
