

## **English**

Reading - All children will engage with quality literature and poetry which tell different stories from different people. All children will explore a diverse range of academic text with a focus on acquiring a deep and word rich vocabulary. We will use VIPERS for our comprehension skills.

Writing - All children will experience texts that reflect cultural, social and linguistic diversity, as well as introducing a world beyond the familiar. Focussed learning will be the foundation of every lesson with an emphasis on knowledge and skills that are spaced, progressive and revisited.

#### RE

During RE lessons, we will be identifying what beliefs are. Identify how what challenges are faced by people based on their beliefs and how to overcome these challenges. Identify meaning from quotes and restate them in our own words. Comparing and contrasting people different beliefs. We will be focusing on the religion Hinduism.
