Reading at home everyday will support your child to make good progress.

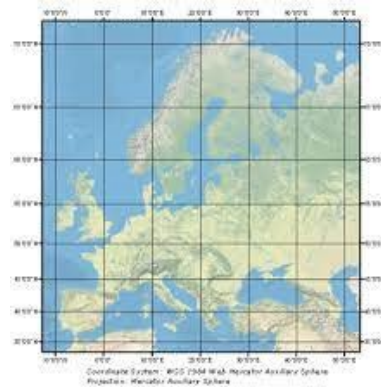
Each week in homework, spellings will relate to vocabulary learned in the week's lessons and a grammar activity, using grammar skills learned in their lessons to.
