Combine them with wool, string, netting, lolly sticks, straws and floral fabric to create a textured collage garden.</p> <p>Date: Signed:</p>	<p>Homemade Lemonade Combine lemon juice, water, and sugar into a large jug and stir until sugar is completely dissolved.
