Communication, Language and Literacy

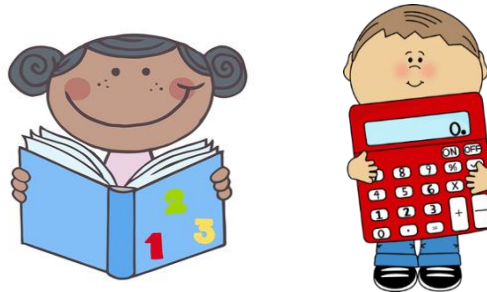
- Recognise and write my name.
