
## **Self-quizzing**

Students were provided with knowledge organisers and self-quizzing resources on their last day in school, and should be using these daily to quiz. Updated knowledge organisers for the Summer term have now been uploaded onto the Academy website, and details of our Curriculum can be found on the Academy website (under "Curriculum") and knowledge organisers can also be found on the Academy website (under "Learning Resources").

We will be launching "live" online lessons for year 8 in Microsoft Teams from Monday 18<sup>th</sup> May, and students will have 6-7 live lessons per week moving forward. All work from next week will be set on MS Teams This letter outlines key information regarding how to access online lessons.

#### Live lessons from home


We will be introducing "live" online lessons from Monday 18<sup>th</sup> May 2020. For this, students will need to utilise their Academy email address. To access, please visit the Academy website and scroll to the bottom of the page. In the "Remote Working" section select "Webmail." This will also allow students to email their teachers any questions.

Students will then need to access Microsoft Teams. This can be downloaded onto laptops/computers, and is also available as an app. Students can log in using their Academy email address. Information on how to login to Microsoft Teams is attached. Further guidance can also be found on the "Work From Home" section on the website, again at the bottom of the page.



Once selected, students have further guidance on a range of online services, including Microsoft Teams. Any issues please email servicedesk@oasisuk.org outlining the student, academy and issue.

Once logged in, students will have access to virtual classrooms. Their teachers will invite them to lessons, and lessons will be delivered virtually. Teachers will set students online assignments for students to complete, and they will be able to communicate via the chat function. It is important students' turn off their camera and audio, they attend all sessions, submit their assignments and remain professional on the chat at all times. There will be a follow up for any students who behave poorly during these online lessons, those who do not attend or complete assignments.

Students in year 8 will have 6-7 "live" lessons per week. It would be really useful if students have paper and their pencil case available for these sessions.

Please see the timetable for year 8 which will run weekly beginning on 18th May overleaf. It is important students are logged into their class for the start time. Please note, there will be no lessons during the half term break, students will have their final lesson of this half term on Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> May, and the timetable will then resume on Monday 1<sup>st</sup> June.




