Dear parents and families,

I hope you are well. Our new Early Years outdoor area is looking great, and ahead of schedule. All children up to Year 6 will get to visit the new area in the new year.

An advance notice that from after February half term, children in Reception upwards will finish school at 3.20pm. We extended the school day to 3.30pm during covid to allow for social distancing between families collecting their children. There are so few children left at 3.20pm now that this is the obvious next step, freeing up all school adults to crack on with their work after school. Nursery will continue to finish at 3.30pm with the option as you have now of collecting from 3.10pm.

We will also be starting up our enrichment activities again after February half term for children in reception upwards, after a long pause due to covid, which children can attend for free. We are in the process of working out a wonderful timetable that we will share with you in due course. I need to dig out my netball gear once more! These will be at various times – before school, lunch, after school – and for specific year groups or phases and will be a case of ‘just turn up’ rather than having to be pre-booked. 

### November Oasis Habit: Hopeful



### Nursery News

**Next week** We will be reading the **exciting and fun** story **Stick Man** by **Julia Donaldson**, 'Stick Man lives in the family tree with his Stick Lady Love and their stick children three.' But it's dangerous being a Stick Man.

A dog wants to play with him, a swan builds her nest with him. He even ends up on a fire! Will he ever get back to the family tree in time for Christmas? Perhaps Santa can help. In maths we shall practise linking numerals and amounts: for example, showing the right number of objects to match the numeral. Children's thinking will be extended by asking probing questions such as: are there more teddies on this flash card or this one? How do you know? Can you find that number on the caterpillar?

On Phonic Monday we will play a game called 'Kim's Game.' Objects with the initial letter sound 'i' will be placed in the center of the carpet. The objects are named and then covered up. One object is removed without the children seeing. Children take turns in saying which object is missing. When the correct object is guessed emphasis is made on sounding out the initial letter. This game not only helps to support language and phonic recognition but also promotes the development of memory and observation skills. Why not try this game at home, any objects can be used.

**Sound of the week: 'i'** Please also practise the initial letter sound of your child's name at home.

## The Orchard News

This week, in shared reading, children enjoyed the book There's a Bear on My Chair by Ross Collins, a rhyming story that looks at what happens when a problem is just too big to tackle ...

During maths lessons, we have started exploring basic 2D and 3D shapes. Children have been learning to identify shapes in the environment.

In science this week, we have continued to learn about the five groups of vertebrates with a focus on animals' different diets.

Next week's book will be My Hair, by Hannah Lee, a joyous, vibrant, and colourful story that captures the excitement of getting ready for a party, as well as celebrating black hair and showcasing a dazzling array of amazing hairstyles.
