About the Course

The Edexcel BTEC Level 3 Certificate in Travel and Tourism is a 30-credit and approximately 180 guided learning hour qualification that consists of **two** mandatory units **plus** optional units that provide for a combined total of 30 credits.

There are 3 units to learn this year:

Unit 1 – Investigating the Travel and Tourism Sector (10 credits)

Unit 3 – The UK as a destination (10 credits)

Unit 7 – European destinations (10 credits)

Assessment:

There is no exam for this course. There are assessments at the end of each unit where students will either get a fail, pass, merit or distinction for their work. There assessments are due at the end of each term.

Term 1

- Unit 7 – European destinations (10 credits)
